This story begins with the youngest person at the seder asking the Four Questions (Mah Nishtanah). These questions provide the impetus for telling why this night is different from all other nights. The Four Questions | My Jewish Learning The Four Questions in English Translation. On all other nights we eat leavened products and matzah, and on this night only matzah. On all other nights we eat all vegetables, and on this night only bitter herbs. On all other nights, we don't dip our food even once, and on this night we dip twice. On all other nights we eat sitting or reclining, and on this night we only recline. Asking the Four Questions at Passover - ThoughtCo The Four Questions are an important part of the Passover seder that highlights the ways in which Passover customs and foods distinguish the holiday from other times of the year. They are traditionally recited by the youngest person at the table during the fifth part of the seder, though in some homes everyone reads them aloud together.

Parsley represents new life and spring while salt water represents tears of Hebrew slaves and how hard the Jewish slaves worked in Egypt. Parsley dipped in salt water thus represents new life that emerged from the tears and hardship of the Jewish slaves. Bitter herbs dipped into Charoset represent the bitter days of slavery.

The Four Questions Explained - An anthology of classic and ... Development of the Four Questions. We find many different versions of the Four Questions in the various manuscripts of the Talmud not only in the order of the questions, but in the number as well. Some versions, for example, omit the question about bitter herbs; others omit the question about the Paschal lamb, even in Temple times.
