Unlike most members of the family Canidae, foxes have partially retractable claws. Fox vibrissae, or whiskers, are black. The whiskers on the muzzle, mystaciae vibrissae, average 100-110 mm (3.9-4.3 in) long, while the whiskers everywhere else on the head average to be shorter in length. Red and Gray fox damage control and management The red fox (*Vulpes vulpes*) is the most common of the foxes native to North America. Most depredation problems are associated with red foxes, although in some areas gray foxes (*Urocyon cinereoargenteus*) can cause problems.
